“CODE OF ETHICS” of the MASS FINISHING JOB SHOPS ASSOCIATION:

The MASS FINISHING JOB SHOPS ASSOCIATION has the long range goal of improving the image of the mass finishing job shop. More immediately, it is committed to upgrade the image and stature of the Association and of all of its Members.

To meet this commitment and to promote its continued growth and services, the Association has to depend on the mutual trust and confidence of and between its members. It believes that member-to-member contacts must be above reproach from every possible ethical and moral standpoint. One member cannot have a conversation, phone call, visit or other contact from another member and worry that the information gained by the other member will one day be used against him.
